2023 -2024 Member Dues:

The Board of Directors met on Monday to approve the 2023-2024 budget and member dues. Despite the consistent and significant inflationary pressures, after 2-years of strong financial performance coming out of the pandemic, including the benefits of the partnership with Playfly Sports Properties, the Board of Directors has accepted the recommendation of staff to have no increase to membership fees next year. BCSS understands the pressures around funding school sport, and is continuing to work to mitigate costs as much as possible.

It should be noted, as was communicated post-AGM that the Legislative Assembly did pass a static championship site fee, that schools in the Eastern Valley, Fraser North, South Fraser and VS2S will be assessed a 24% of base dues contribution, while those in the other zones will be assessed 10% of base dues. This money will go to support those teams required to travel on an annual basis due to a static site championship. 100% of the funds collected through this static site fee, will be returned to member schools to defer approximately 9-14% of their travel costs to static site championships. These fees are **not** reflected in the above chart.



We will send the membership opt-in information to Principals of record in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of August. If the principal at your school is changing, please let us know immediately so we can update our records. Dues invoices will be sent out once the 23-24 opt-in is completed.

Policy Committee Chairs:

We are still seeking individuals to chair two important policy committees. The Individual Sports Championship Committee as well as the Spring Sports Rules Committee require the chair to be an Athletic Director, or school or district-based administrator. These chairs also receive a voting seat on the BCSS Legislative Assembly which meets in November and May. The rules committee will meet 2-3 times a year, virtually. While the Individual Sports Championship Committee will meet 3-4 times a year, with the potential for one in-person meeting.
