# 2. BCSS GRANTS & GAMING MONEY

Christine Bradstock provided the following update:

- Each Commission recently received a message regarding the annual Grant as well as Gaming funds available and listed the items to be reported on.

# 4. OTHER BUSINESS / INFORMATION SHARING:

**4.1** Field Hockey was wondering what other commissions do regarding Championship registration fees for local schools vs travelling schools.

Badminton – If Championships are always in the lower mainland, rather than rotating around the province, the local schools pay more for registration, travelling schools pay less (the balance is the local school does not have to pay travel costs).

Rugby – Rugby's play-offs are two stage. First stage of play-offs are held in outlying areas and second stage is held in the lower mainland. Championship registration fees are the same for all teams.

Boys Basketball wants to start the dialogue regarding seasons of play. Championships for Girls and Boys Basketball is starting to be facility driven, and as a result at the May 2013 AGM the question was put forth to change the season of play in order to allow AAA & AAAA tiers of Boys Basketball Championships to be held at the same date/location.

Discussion included:

- How does changing the season of play affect Fall & Spring season sports?
- Would a compromise be to start Spring Season a week earlier?
- Spring season is affected by both Spring break (effectively 2 weeks) & grad in June.

**ACTION:** Boys Basketball will continue the discussion with the Commissions.
